- WHEREAS, Everett School District No. 2., Snohomish County, Washington, has adopted a Building Fund Budget for school year 1954-1955 in the amount of \$517,663.92, that amount being all the money that was available at the time of adoption, and,
- WHEREAS, The extra demands placed on the School District for capital outlay expenditures during the 1954-1955 school year will exceed the amount budgeted there having been purchased additional school sites and several portable classrooms constructed, and,
- WHEREAS, There has been collected since July 1, 1954, interest in the amount of \$14,260.53 on U. S. Certificates of Delinquency on Building Fund investments and \$447.18 collected in delinquent taxes, and,
- WHEREAS, These amounts are available for capital outlay expenditures, and,
  WHEREAS, Sections 4867 and 4868 of Remington's Revised Statutes provides for
  the adoption of a resolution declaring an emergency and making an
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That an emergency exists and that an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$14,700.00 be, and hereby is made; and that unpaid obligations for the year 1954-1955 be considered as part of expenditures for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1955,
- AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the said School District be instructed to file a certified copy of this emergency Resolution with the County Auditor, County Treasurer, and County Superintendent of Schools as authority to issue warrants drawn on the Building Fund on the order of the Board of Directors.
