MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF EVERETT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 2.

MEMBERS PRESENT: MC IVOR, HUNTER, SEGOY AND ZEMPEL.

THE BOARD ASSEMBLED TO DISCUSS THE REFUSAL OF LOCAL NO. 191 OF INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF ELECTRICIANS TO FURNISH MEN FOR ELECTRICAL REPAIR THAT IS CONTEMPLATED IN A NUMBER OF SCHOOLS THIS SUMMER. THE UNION HAD PREVIOUSLY INFORMED THE BOARD THAT WORK COULD BE DONE ONLY UNDER CONTRACT OR THROUGH LOCAL ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS. AFTER DISCUSSION THE FOLLOWING WAS PROPOSED FOR ADOPTION:

RESOLUTION NO. 20

WHEREAS, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF EVERETT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 2 HAVE HERETOFORE PLANNED TO RE-LIGHT THE EVERETT HIGH SCHOOL, THE MONROE GRADE SCHOOL, AND THE GARFIELD GRADE SCHOOL BY THE INSTALLATION OF MODERN SCHOOLROOM LIGHTING EQUIPMENT, AND

WHEREAS, LOCAL NO. 191 OF THE INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF ELECTRICAL WORKERS IN EVERETT, WASHINGTON, REFUSES TO SUPPLY ELECTRICIANS TO THE EVERETT SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE PURPOSE OF CARRYING OUT THE WITHIN PROJECTS, AND

WHEREAS, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE EVERETT SCHOOL DISTRICT STANDS READY TO HIRE ELECTRICIANS OUT OF SAID UNION AT THE UNION WAGE SCALE AND UNDER EXISTING UNION CONDITIONS,

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED,

1. THAT IN VIEW OF THE REFUSAL OF THE LOCAL ELECTRICIANS' UNION TO FURNISH ELECTRICIANS THAT IT IS TO THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE DISTRICT THAT THE WORK HEREINABOVE CONTEMPLATED SHALL NOT BE DONE THIS SUMMER BUT SHALL BE POSTPONED INDEFINITELY AND UNTIL SUCH A TIME AS THE DISTRICT IS ABLE TO HIRE ELECTRICIANS, AND
2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE EVERETT SCHOOL DISTRICT STANDS READY TO HIRE ELECTRICIANS FROM LOCAL UNION NO. 191 AND PAY TO SAID ELECTRICIANS THE UNION WAGE SCALE AND TO HIRE SAID ELECTRICIANS UNDER UNION CONDITIONS AT ANY TIME THEY ARE FURNISHED.

ROLL CALL RESULTED IN SEGOY, HUNTER AND MC IVOR VOTING "YEA" AND ZEMPEL, "NAY".
