Resolution No. 23²³

A RESOLUTION providing for the acceptance by Everett School District No. 2 of the sum of Forty Thousand (\$40,000.00) Dollars for a right of way through the Lowell School grounds, and authorizing the president and secretary of the Board of Education of said district to execute whatever instruments may be necessary in connection with said matter.

WHEREAS, the State Highway Department of the State of Washington has planned and laid out a super highway between Beverly Park and Everett, and

WHEREAS, the line of said highway goes through the grounds of the Lowell School, and

WHEREAS, said Highway Department has indicated that unless a proper settlement can be arranged they will take steps to condemn said right of way, and

WHEREAS, after negotiations between said district and said State Highway Department, a price of Forty Thousand (\$40,000.00) Dollars has been agreed upon for said right of way, which is considered a fair settlement ,

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SAID BOARD OF EDUCATION OF SAID EVERETT SCHOOL DISTRICT No. 2 That said sum of Forty Thousand (\$40,000.00) Dollars be accepted for said right of way and that the president and secretary of said Board of Directors be, and they are hereby authorized, to execute whatever conveyances are necessary in order to convey said right of way to said State Highway Department and to receive said sum of Forty Thousand (\$40,000.00) Dollars in payment thereof.

It is also understood that said right of way will be fenced with a proper fence by the State Highway Department along the top of the slopes, and said District will be permitted to retain such portions of said right of way as may be without said fence lines until December 31, 1952, for the purpose of conducting school thereon and until a school can be erected on another site.

Passed by the Board of Directors of the Everett School District on the 12th day of September, 1949, *provided an underpass is built as indicated on present plans.*
