

RESOLUTION 588

REDUCED EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM & REDUCTION OF STAFF

WHEREAS, the final 1995-97 State operating budget, including the supplemental budget adopted in 1996, has a negative impact on the District's ability to maintain its current educational service levels; and

WHEREAS, the District is currently projecting that expenditures for 1995-96 will exceed revenues by more than \$2,000,000 and the District's actual expenditures for 1994-95 exceeded revenues by \$1,668,729, and

WHEREAS, in order to reduce District expenditures to the level of reasonably anticipated revenues, it is necessary to make certain reductions in the District's education program, including reductions in certificated, classified, and administrative positions for the 1996-97 school year;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Everett School District that:


1. The Superintendent is directed to develop a reduced educational program for 1996-97; and
2. The Superintendent is directed to prepare a 1996-97 operating budget which reduces expenditures to the level of reasonably anticipated revenues; and
3. The Superintendent is directed to take such action as may be required by law to notify administrative and classified employees who will be affected by reduction of positions; and
4. The Superintendent is authorized to make such other plans to implement this reduced educational programs as are necessary to comply with the legal obligations of the District.
