

RESOLUTION NO. 603

AUTHORIZATION TO EMPLOY RETIRED TEACHERS AS SUBSTITUTE
CLASSROOM TEACHERS

This is a resolution from the Everett School District No. 2 Board of Directors petitioning the State Board of Education for approval of an authorization to employ retired teachers as substitute classroom teachers.

WHEREAS, the Everett School District, Snohomish County, Washington, is a first class district under the statutes of the State of Washington; and


WHEREAS, the legislature will allow retired teachers to substitute an additional 15 days (105 hours) per school year, beyond the 75 days (525 hours) currently allowed without affecting their retirement benefit, and;

WHEREAS, as the District exhausts its list of available and qualified substitutes it desires to hire retired teachers for classroom teacher substitute services to address the shortage of qualified and available substitutes;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Superintendent of the Everett School District, Everett, Washington, is authorized to hire retired teachers for an additional 15 days (105 hours) of employment beyond the 75 days (525 hours) currently permitted as the District exhausts its list of available and qualified substitutes in the 1996-97 school year.




