The purpose of this agreement is to utilize interdistrict cooperation, authorized by RCW 28A.58.075, RCW 28A.58.245 and Chapter 392-135 WAC to provide educational programs not otherwise available and to avoid duplications of specialized programs and facilities. These objectives will be achieved by the following described cooperative program: The general purpose of this cooperative shall be to provide vocational education programs and services to high school students of the participating district at the Clover Park School District Elective High School.

Transportation of students to or from facilities where program and/or program services are located is an essential part of this cooperative. Such transportation will be provided as follows: The parent/guardian of the student/adult student will be responsible for transportation.
