Annexation of James Monroe Elementary School Property to the City of Everett

RESOLUTION NO. 846

A resolution of the Board of Directors of Everett School District No. 2, Snohomish County, Washington, authorizing the Superintendent to petition the City Council of the City of Everett for annexation of the James Monroe Elementary School site to the City of Everett.

WHEREAS, the James Monroe Elementary School site is contiguous to the current city limits of the City of Everett as a result of a recent annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has determined that it is in the best interests of the District to authorize the Superintendent to petition the City Council of the City of Everett for annexation of the James Monroe Elementary school site to the City of Everett; and

WHEREAS, RCW 28A.335.110 authorizes the Board of Directors of a school district to petition for the annexation of school property to a city or town, so long as such school property constitutes the whole of such property in the annexation petition;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Everett School District No. 2, Snohomish County, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. Annexation Petition

The Superintendent of the District is hereby authorized and directed to petition the City Council of the City of Everett for annexation of the James Monroe Elementary School site to the City of Everett, so long as that site constitutes the whole of the property described in the annexation petition. The legal description of the site is attached hereto as Exhibit A. Subject to the provisions of this Section 1, the Superintendent is further authorized and directed, to style and structure the petition to accommodate, to the extent reasonably practicable and consistent with law, the annexation process preferences of City of Everett staff.


