Schedule information for all high school juniors:

Wednesday, Oct 12: The Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test (PSAT) date for high school juniors. This test, which usually costs \$25, is being given for the first time at no cost to all juniors. Testing will begin at 7:30 a.m. on that day. School buses will run as usual on Wednesday morning, Oct. 12 to pick up juniors for the PSAT.

Schedule information for high school freshmen, sophomores and juniors who need additional classroom help:

Wednesday, Oct 12: Academic support classes will be provided for freshman, sophomore and senior students who need additional help during this time. These support classes for freshmen, sophomore and seniors will also start at 7:30. We will send a Connect-Ed message on the evening of Monday, Oct 10 inviting students who need to attend the morning support sessions.

Schedule information for all other high school freshmen, sophomores and juniors:

School buses will make a second run later in the morning of Wednesday, Oct. 12 to pick up students who, because they are up-to-date in class work, do not need to come in early for support or for testing. For these students, buses will run three hours later than they usually do. The later buses will still have the same bus drivers, bus numbers, and bus stops. The remainder of the school day for all students will continue through the regular dismissal time to include class periods 4, 5, and 6.

Sophomore PSAT

The PSAT, a practice test for the SAT, has been scheduled for **Saturday October 15th at Evergreen Middle School** for all **sophomores** in the Everett District. Beginning Thursday September 29th sophomores can start registering to take the PSAT. To register you need to bring a check or cash for the **\$25.00 test fee** to the Treasurer's office before school, after school or during student lunches. The deadline for registering for the PSAT is **Monday October 10th**. Space is limited so make sure to sign up soon. Students will receive the PSAT study guide upon registering for the test.
