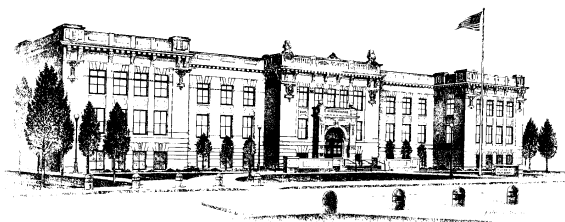

Announcements: Orders taken on November 3/4th in Cafeteria during lunches. Announcements will be distributed in April. **Contact Herff-Jones at 425-488-7213 if you did not make it to the cafeteria.**

Caps & Gowns: Orders taken on November 3/4th in Cafeteria during lunches. All graduates will wear official school caps and gowns during the commencement exercise. Herff-Jones is the designated supplier for these items. Contact Jeff Woods at (425) 488-7213 if you have any questions. Caps/gowns will be distributed in June. Gowns are rented and need to be returned.

Clearance Forms: Seniors will be issued Clearance Forms in May. Clearance Forms must be properly signed and returned to Mrs. Walsh in the Treasurer's Office before students are allowed to walk. Commencement tickets will not be issued until Clearance Forms are returned.

Commencement Rehearsals: It is mandatory ALL seniors participate in rehearsals. Dates to be announced.

Commencement Tickets: Each senior will receive ten tickets. These will be distributed **during rehearsal** to students who have turned in their completed clearance forms. Request forms for more tickets will be available in May.

Culminating Exhibition: ALL CE work must be at standard to present and be eligible to walk across the stage on June 16th.

Diploma/Grades: Diploma, Certificate of Immunization Status, Report Card, and Final Transcript will be available to be picked up at the high school Main Office after July 5th – check website for summer hours.

Senior Ball: The Senior Ball will be held in **June**. Tickets will be sold in the Treasurer's office starting in May. More information to follow on ticket prices and specifics.

Senior Grad Night Party: Grad Night Party is an all-night celebration for seniors **sponsored by the Class of 2012 parents**. Seniors depart (after the Graduation Ceremony) on chartered buses to an undisclosed location and are brought back the following morning. The evening is a fun night full of surprises -- typically music, food, and games are all packed in to an alcohol-free evening for the students. - If a senior photo is not submitted we will use the photo taken at Seagull Day.
- Composition of background is your choice (inside *or* outside shot)

Format: .JPG, .TIFF, or .PSD file at a minimum resolution of 300dpi

Orientation: Portrait (vertical) orientation only!

Media: USB, CD or send as an attachment to EHSyearbook2012@gmail.com

Be sure that emailed file sizes are at least one megabyte in size in order to publish well.

Document Name: Last Name, First Name.
