Athletic legacy to be preserved in Everett High gym remodel

Gym sections built in the 1960s and 1980s will showcase legacy in new athletic facility – thanks to voter approval of the 2006 school construction bond.



For decades, students and community members have relied upon the Everett High School gymnasium as a location for community gatherings, rousing athletic competitions, youth and adult sports activities and the location for high school PE classes.

Those activities will continue through winter 2013, even while both the north and south ends of the gym are deconstructed and reconstructed once again. The end result will be what some are calling a "state of the art" high school athletic facility and community use venue.

In February 2006, voters approved a district construction bond that has built one new school (Forest View Elementary) and remodeled and rebuilt others in the last six years. The renovation of the EHS gym is one of the final construction projects detailed in that bond proposal.

Floor plans for the project are published on the district website, and more details about the project appear in a Nov. 1, 2012 front page story of the *Everett Herald*.
