Everett Public Schools welcomes next year's kindergarten students

Although this school year is not yet finished, and there are seven more months before the next school year begins, it is time to think about <u>kindergarten registration</u> for next year.

Children who will be 5 years old by August 31, 2013, are eligible to begin kindergarten in September. To ensure that there are enough teachers and classrooms ready for next year's youngest students, district elementary schools will begin registering kindergarten students starting Monday, March 11 for the 2013-14 school year. Registration materials will be available at the district website www.everett.k12.wa.us on March 4 and at elementary schools on March 6.

Initial application for All Day Kindergarten ends Friday, March 15 at noon. Lotteries will be held the afternoon of March 15 at schools when applications exceed spaces.

Families planning to register in March are asked to bring:

- Completed registration forms
- Child's birth certificate or passport documentation. Birth certificates for children born in Washington State may be obtained at the <u>Snohomish Health District</u> Vital Statistics office (425-339-5280). Out-of-state birth certificates may be ordered from <u>VitalChek</u>.
- Proof of residence (a utility or phone bill, rental agreement, etc.)
- Certificate of Immunization and Child's Health History. Contact your child's physician or the Snohomish Health District at 425-339-5220 regarding information about vaccinations and updates. A <u>parent's guide to immunizations</u> is also available through the Snohomish Health District's website.
