Administrative Organization

If the superintendent is out of the district and/or unavailable for communication for extended periods, or otherwise unable to perform his/her duties due to emergencies or other reasons, the succession of authority and responsibility to act on behalf of the superintendent will be as follows until and unless the school board convenes and by a majority vote decides otherwise.

2. Associate Superintendent, Curriculum, Assessment and Special Programs
3. Assistant Superintendent, Teaching and Learning, Central Region
4. Assistant Superintendent, Teaching and Learning, South Region
5. Assistant Superintendent, Human Resources, Equity and Access
6. Chief Information Systems and Technology Officer
7. Executive Director, Facilities and Operations
8. Executive Director, Finance and Business Services
9. Executive Director, Special Services
10. Director, Curriculum, Assessment and Research
11. Director, Categorical Programs
