

The Schack Art Center is offering the fourteenth annual Art Technique Workshop Series for credit or clock hours. This course consists of 4 evening sessions (Apr. 10, 17, 24, & May 1) taught by Nancy Jordan/Deborah Barten, local art educators. This class will focus on familiarizing teachers with tools for the K-8 classroom to help their students learn how to closely observe the physical world and communicate that visually using a variety of art forms and media. The first session will explore the purpose and importance in developing sharp observation skills. This concept will then be demonstrated through instruction and practice using the techniques of drawing, painting, collage and 3D sculpture.

To give participants background on the appropriate means for teaching observation skills through art in the classroom, including:

- Teachers, youth service providers, parent volunteers, art docents, and interested individuals who want to improve and increase their knowledge and skill and thereby feel more comfortable teaching and creating art.
