RESOLUTION NO. 1050

MONROE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ASSET PRESERVATION SYSTEM

WHEREAS, WAC 392-347-023 is intended to protect the public capital investment of all post-1993 state assisted facilities through the appropriate levels of maintenance in order to be eligible for future state capital funding assistance, and;


WHEREAS, in order to comply with WAC 392-347-023 the district shall adopt a resolution committing the district to maintain this school facility to a safe and healthy standard through the implementation of an asset preservation system within six months from acceptance by the school district's board of directors, and;

WHEREAS, an asset preservation system is a system of tasks or projects that are active, reactive or proactive in maintaining the day-to-day health, safety and instructional quality of the school facility and tasks or projects that are proactive, predictive or preventative in maintaining the school facility over its thirty-year expected life cycle and;


WHEREAS, Monroe Elementary School was constructed with state matching funds and accepted by the Everett Public Schools board of directors on December 11, 2012;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Everett Public Schools board of directors does hereby commit the Everett Public Schools to maintain Monroe Elementary School in a safe, healthy and educationally effective manner through the adoption of an asset preservation system for this facility.


