WHEREAS volunteers, with their diverse talents and true dedication, nurture students throughout their school years.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Everett Public Schools Board of Directors recognizes April 21-27, to
be National Volunteer Appreciation Week; and sends its sincere gratitude to our volunteers.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Everett Public Schools Board of Directors strongly encourages all members
of our community to join in this observance, recognizing the dedication and hard work of these individuals.






