Hawthorne Elementary School receives coveted Monte Cristo award

More than 50 students, parents and community members helped with annual beautification day

The school neighborhood project extends beyond what is normal for school maintenance. The work expands to encompass learning experiences for students – and even provides a food source for families in the summer.

"Our counselor, <u>Gloria Stablein</u>, and parents who worked with <u>AmeriCorp</u> (a corporation for national and community service) installed raised garden beds in the commons between our buildings," explained Phinney. "Classes adopt the beds during the year, and family volunteers tend the gardens during the summer."

Hawthorne Elementary School community not only cares for their students; they care about their school and neighborhood as well!

"On our annual beautification day we had more than 50 students, parents, and community members show up to pick up trash, pull weeds, and spread beauty bark," said Principal Janelle Phinney.

Their work did not go unnoticed. Their school was selected as a winner of the *Neighborhood Friendly Business Monte Cristo* award. The Council of Neighborhoods chooses award winners from properties that have been nominated by the community.
