



School is boring/ Not motivated

Likelihood that a high school dropout will go to prison compared to a high school graduate

High school dropouts aged 16-24 with no job in 2009

9 to 1 -

Likelihood that a high school dropout will be a single parent living in poverty compared to a college graduate

\$9,200

Average amount more per year
