



Middle School Courses for High School Credit

Everett Public Schools students may receive high school credit for specific middle school courses, per [Board Procedure 2410](#).

High school credit bearing courses taken in middle school will automatically be added to the student's transcript, unless requested otherwise by the student and the student's family per Board Policy 2410. Once the middle school course has been removed, it cannot be added back to the transcript. Students and their families can request eligible courses to be removed from their high school transcript any time up through end of the student's 11th grade school year.

Please contact your school registrar for the necessary paperwork to remove or add middle school credits to high school transcripts.

The following middle school courses are currently available for high school credit:

*All students who pass Washington State History (WSH) in middle school earn a "MET" status on their high school transcript. This is an automatic process that takes place when a student successfully completes the course.
