

SHOE FUND DONATIONS NEEDED!

Did you know that many students in the Everett School District do not have proper fitting shoes, or have shoes that are so worn out that they are no longer functional? These students often do not have the funds to purchase new shoes or even used ones from a thrift shop. While there are programs that provide students with free clothes, many do not provide shoes.

The Everett PTSA Council's Shoe Fund program helps to fill that gap in services! We provide gift cards to Payless Shoes (purchased at a discount) to these students in need. We work directly with school counselors and family advocates who identify which students in need. Pre-K and Elementary students receive cards valued at \$25.00, while middle and high school students receive cards valued at \$30.00.

The program has already given out 260 cards to students across the district this school year, but we have a waiting list of more than 170 students and the program is currently out of funds! We are seeking your donations to help these students who are waiting, plus the additional requests we anticipate this school year.

All donations are tax deductible and a receipt will be mailed to the address provided.
