

Read the Cards: "Read" the cards to your child. Next, show the child the cards one at a time and have him/her read it to you. If your child doesn't remember the name of the letter, simply give them the name.

If your child is just beginning to learn the names of letters, start with only a few (such as the letters in his/her first name). Slowly add one or two letters at a time. You might choose letters they see at other times (on labels that you've made together, on road signs, in the title of their favorite book or in their brother or sister's name).

Sing the Alphabet: Sing the alphabet song and put the cards in alphabetical order. "A, B, C, D, E, F, G... now I know my ABC's. Next time won't you sing with me?"
