Wentworth is one of four selected from more than 20 from this region



Tony Wentworth, principal of Whittier Elementary, is among more than 20 elementary principals nominated to represent this region in the state's *Principal of the Year* honorary process. He is one of the top four from that group to have earned a title of 2016 Regional Distinguished Principal.

The Association of Washington School Principals (AWSP) describes the award as "a tribute to your deep and professional commitment to the children of your school. This represents the pride and admiration of your colleagues for your efforts to promote positive school-community relations, for implementing instructional programs leading to academic excellence."
