One of six students selected to attend July leadership conference in Washington D.C.

Garry Larson, a junior at Everett High School, has been a GEAR UP student since seventh grade. He is involved in extra-curricular activities, athletics and band, and is an excellent student. His teachers note how he gets involved in activities to better himself and learn whenever he can.
