Community

Spanning 39 square miles, Everett Public Schools serves the educational needs of 19,606 students throughout their 26 schools. As the tenth largest school district in Washington State based on the number of families and children living in our district, it is located in one of the state's fastest growing areas and the district enjoys a diversified economic base. Currently, the district consists of twenty-six schools that include four high schools, five middle schools, and 17 elementary schools utilizing a K-5, 6-8, 9-12 grade-level configuration. The student body is culturally diverse with a student population that is 17.3% Hispanic, 4% African American, 57.8% White and 12.5% Asian, .7% American Indian/Alaskan Native, and 1.4% Native Hawaiian/Other Pacific Islander.

School

Everett High School is a comprehensive four-year public high school enrolling 1,500 students in grades 9-12. Built in 1909, Everett High School's main building was placed on the National Registry of historic places after extensive renovation in 1995. Everett High students attend classes in the Little Theater, Everett Civic Auditorium, gymnasium, cafeteria and science buildings. Everett High's central location and modern facilities are frequent sites for community, state and national events. School colors are blue and gold and the mascot is a seagull.

Curriculum

Students at Everett High School earn 6.0 credits per year. The school year is divided into two semesters with six classes offered daily each worth 0.5 credit. A total of 22 credits are required to receive an Everett High School diploma for the class of 2016. Online High School classes may be incorporated into the school day or, for a fee, may be taken to gain more than 6.0 credits during the school year. Local colleges and universities offer credit options for our students and the Sno-Isle Skills Center is available for students seeking vocational curriculum. Students can access Honors classes at Everett High School, in addition to college level courses through Running Start, Tech Prep, College in the High School and Advanced Placement classes.

Grade Point Average (GPA) Calculation

Grade point averages (GPAs) are cumulative and computed annually. Only courses with letter grades are calculated in the GPA. Everett High School does not rank students but provides a decile standing. GPA is based on the traditional 4-point scale (at right). EHS does not weight grades. All subjects are included in determination of decile standing and GPA including College in the High School and Running Start. Grades are recorded on the transcript and GPA is computed in January and June.

Class of 2015

95.8% of the students in the class of 2015 graduated within four years of entering ninth grade.

Standardized Test Results

42% (115) of the EHS class of 2015 took the SAT®.

Advanced Placement Results

- In 2015, 277 EHS students enrolled in AP courses
- A total of 441 exams were taken by Everett High School students
- 27% of the AP exams taken by Everett High School students received qualifying scores of 3 or higher

Post High School Placement

- 27% matriculated to 4-year colleges
- 22% matriculated to 2-year institutions
- 51% selected work, military service or technical instruction
