FOOD PREFERENCE POLICY

Snohomish County ECEAP appreciates the diversity of our families and will make efforts to accommodate religious, ethnic, cultural or vegetarian food preferences when possible. When a family identifies that they have a religious, ethnic, cultural or vegetarian food preference, the ECEAP staff will ensure that a Food Preference form is completed. The original copy of the Food Preference form is kept in the child's file and a copy is sent to the Lead Cook/Food Service Manager. The food preferences will be listed along with the special diets or food allergies in the classroom.

When the Lead Cook/Food Service Manager at an ECEAP site receives a Food Preference Form, he/she will determine what food substitutions will be required and when the Kitchen will be able to provide special meals or food for the child. The Lead Cook/Food Service Manager/Program Manager will consult with the ECEAP Nutritionist as needed regarding food preference or food substitutions and/or special meals for the child. Please note that time is needed to plan food substitutions and/or special meals. When the Food Preference Plan is in place, the Lead Cook/Food Service Manager will contact the Program Manager, who will assign a start date.
