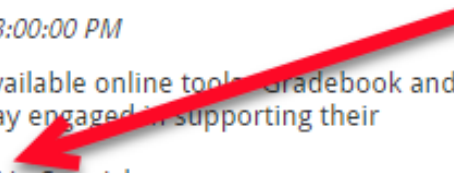

Operations and Algebraic Thinking Represents and solves problems involving multiplication and division; interprets products and quotients of whole numbers; uses multiplication and division within 100 to solve word problems; determines the unknown whole number in a multiplication or division equation relating three whole numbers. Understands properties of multiplication and the relationship between multiplication and division. Multiplies and divides within 100. Solves problems involving the four operations and identifies and explains patterns in arithmetic.		
2. Number and Operations in Base Ten Uses place value understanding and properties of operations to perform multi-digit arithmetic: rounds to the nearest 10 or 100; fluently adds and subtracts within 1,000 using strategies and algorithms; multiplies one-digit whole number by multiples of 10 in the range of 10 - 90.		
3. Number and Operations--Fractions Develops understanding of fractions as numbers: partitioning into equal parts; a number on the number line; explains equivalence of fractions and compares fractions by reasoning about their size.		
4. Measurement and Data Solves problems involving measurement and estimation of intervals of time, liquid, volumes, and masses of objects: tells and writes time to the nearest minute and measures time intervals in minutes; solves word problems involving time; adds, subtracts, multiplies, or divides to solve one-step word problems involving masses or volumes. Represents and interprets data: constructs scaled picture graphs and scaled bar graphs, and solves one- and two-step "how many more" and "how many less" problems using information from scaled bar graphs; generates measurement data to the quarter-inch and displays data in a line plot. Geometric measurement: understands concepts of area and relates area to multiplication and to addition. Geometric measurement: recognizes perimeter as an attribute of plane figures and distinguishes between linear and area measures, and solves real world and mathematical problems involving perimeter.		
5. Geometry Reasons with shapes and their attributes: understands different categories of shapes may share attributes, and that shared attributes can define a larger category; partitions shapes into parts with equal areas.		
6. Reasoning, Problem Solving, and Communication Demonstrates strategic mathematical thinking and reasoning, using what is known to solve problems

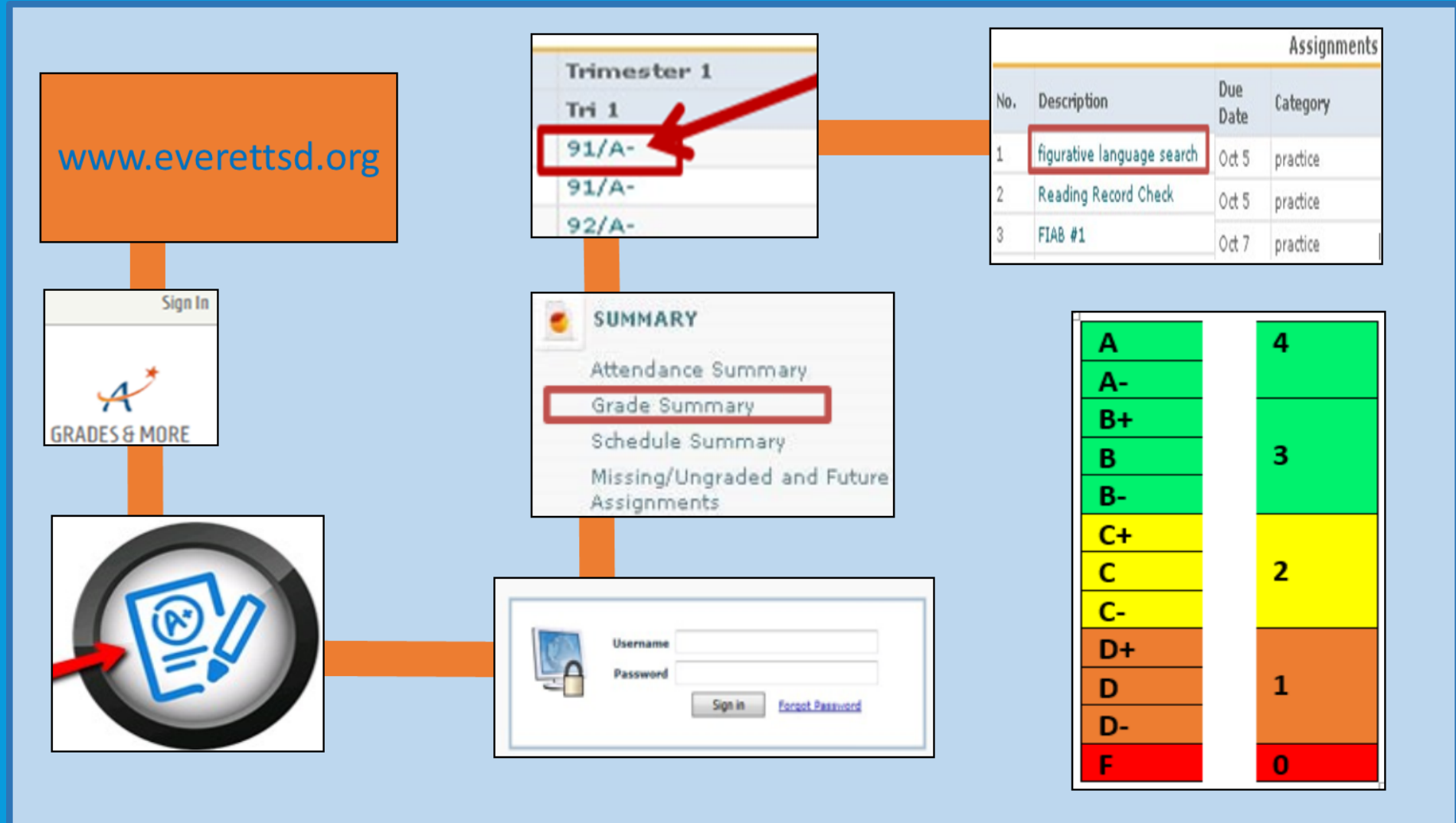
