- Read together every day
- Name the pictures
- Talk about the story
 - ◆ Author
 - ◆ Illustrator
 - ◆ Characters
 - ◆ Setting
 - ◆ What is happening
- Point out familiar letters and words
 - ◆ Letters in child's and family member's name
 - ◆ Familiar words (mom, dad, love)
 - ◆ Words that rhyme
- Read with humor and expression
- Read stories again and again and again
- Tell your child how much you enjoy reading together
- Model the joy of reading by reading your own books
