1. The Everett Public Schools will offer boys and girls middle school soccer as a Washington Interscholastic Activities Association (WIAA) sport beginning in the 2016-2017 school year. This will increase opportunities for both boys and girls to participate in athletics at the middle school level.
2. The Everett Public Schools will offer boys and girls C-team soccer at the high school level beginning in the 2016-2017 school year. This will increase opportunities for both boys and girls to participate in athletics at the high school level.
3. The Student Interest Survey will be administered in December, 2016. The results of this survey will guide discussion about school district athletic offerings and whether additional sports or teams should be added.
