#### RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Everett High School offered a girls wrestling team with a coach dedicated to this program, rather than shared with the boys program. Twenty-four girls started and completed the season. The district should investigate adding girls wrestling coaches at Cascade and Jackson High Schools as well. By offering a separate girls wrestling program it is likely more girls will participate in this sport and increase female athletic participation.
- 2. Schools in the Northshore, Lake Washington, and Bellevue school districts have successfully added girls badminton as a spring sport to increase female participation. Offering this sport in Everett Public Schools may lead to an increase in female athletic participation. In the 2017 Student Interest Survey, 28.6% of the female respondents indicated they would be interested in playing this sport in the spring.
