TRAINING INSTITUTE FOR TEACHERS

The Enhancing Cultural Toolkits and Student Mindsets Institute trains teachers to implement evidencedbased practices that promote student engagement, motivation, and performance. Our goal is to examine how best to train teachers and schools to implement these practices in order to reduce achievement gaps between advantaged and disadvantaged students and to create sustainable cultural change within schools. We partner with educators to identify, empirically test, and disseminate teaching practices and policies that help all students succeed.

- Train teachers to implement practices that promote engagement, belonging, learning, and performance
- Evaluate the efficacy of practices aimed at reducing racial/ethnic and social class achievement gaps
- Improve academic outcomes, particularly among students from disadvantaged backgrounds

The institute offers active and engaging workshops that include educational sessions, collaborative activities, and practical guidelines for implementing practices that foster inclusivity, learning, motivation, and performance.
