Adoption of the Operating Budget for Fiscal Year 2017-18

WHEREAS, Everett School District No. 2, Snohomish County, Washington, is a first-class school district duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the Constitution and the laws of the state of Washington; and

WHEREAS, RCW 28A.505.050 and WAC 392-123-054 requires that the district's fiscal year 2017-18 budget be adopted and tax levies certified on or before August 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, a public notice was published on August 15, 2017, and August 22, 2017, announcing that on August 29, 2017, the board of directors of Everett Public Schools would hold a public meeting for the purpose of fixing and adopting the 2017-18 budget; and

WHEREAS, RCW 28A.320.330 requires an operating transfer from the Capital Fund to the General Fund during the month of November up to \$2,240,000 for the application and modernization of technology systems for operations and instruction and for major equipment repair, painting of facilities, and other major preventive maintenance purposes; and

WHEREAS, the district has certified for 2018 a General Fund Maintenance and Operations Excess Levy in the amount of \$51,000,000, a Debt Service Fund Levy of \$35,790,000, and a Capital Projects Fund Levy in the amount of \$19,000,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors for the Everett School District No. 2 hereby adopts the Operating Budget for Fiscal Year 2017-18 as follows:
