	future so they can reach their post-secondary goals and preview the lessons they will complete in 7 th grade.
	Tell students that you will be watching a short video. At the end you will ask them to tell you what
	the THEME of the video could be. (*do not give it away)

	Ask students for ideas on the video theme when done.
	Tell students that the overall theme of the video is goals . Marshawn Evans set goals for herself
	throughout her life and it helped her to be successful.

	Tell students that they need to follow these steps to review what they wrote last year in their journal.
	Walk around the room as students are locating their goal idea in their journal. IF they do not
	have a goal idea, have them reflect on their 6 th grade year and think about what they might want to
	improve upon in 7 th grade.
	Pass out goal idea handouts out to students and make sure they have a pen, pencil, or highlighter.
	Call on approximately 2-3 students to provide their interpretations.

	Explain to students that they will be selecting the goal topic and a specific goal they want to work
	on this year.
	Pass out 7th Gr goal ideas handout to students and explain that students will now select the goal
	topic and a specific goal they want to work on this year.

DEMO for students how to circle their goal topic and specific goal on your own handout <u>Tell</u> students that they will now go into Naviance to set their **7**th **Grade S.M.A.R.T Goal.** *Show SLIDE 15 When students have entered, their goal topic and Specific goal have students follow along as you WALK THEM THROUGH STEP BY STEP to create their goal. **Select 7th Grade S.M.A.R.T Goal** template from the drop-down arrow. **Choose your own topic as a counselor to demo and type in as you instruct students to follow My qoal is: Students enter the goal topic they circled on their handout **Specific:** Students enter the specific goal they circled **Measurable:** Students enter HOW they can actually measure their goal **Achievable:** Students enter one sentence about why the goal is realistic for them **Relevant:** Students enter one sentence about why their goal is important to them in 6^{th} grade **Timely:** Have students enter the end date of June 15, 2018 as a date that they will achieve this goal by. (This will be approximately the time when you will complete the goal evaluation with them) **Demo & students follow along** to create one action step for approximately 2 weeks from the time the goal is set. **Show** students how they can see their action steps in the **To-Do's** area. (5 min.) *Show SLIDE 23 Survey <u>Tell</u> students to Click on the MY PLANNER tab and then click TASKS ASSIGNED TO ME to complete the GR 7 Lesson Survey - 1 S.M.A.R.T Goals **Instruct** students to either log off and PUT AWAY or log off and KEEP CHROMEBOOKS on their desks depending on if you will be in the same class for the next period
