(10 min.) Credit	*Show SLIDE 19 Review the different types and credit amounts for each content area
Check in	Tell students to take out a pen/pencil and get student help passing out the Graduation Checklist to

	Tell students to check off all the credits they have taken so far and plan to take for the remainder of
	9 th grade that count for high school credit. (*Counselors circulate among students to answer questions)
(10 min.)	*Show SLIDE 24
Entering	Remind students how to locate the Course Planner tool in Naviance.
Credits in	<u>Tell</u> students to look at their Graduation Checklist and use it to update their 9 th grade courses and
