# 2018 FIELD TRIPS

The Intersection of Art + Math Field Trips: May 21–June 1 (may add May 14-18 if needed)

The exhibit will feature artists' works that apply math skills in the creation of an art product such as quilts, collages, patterned prints, perspective drawings, sculptures, tessellations and more. Opening Reception: April 26.

Field Trips last 75 minutes and include a docent led tour, artists in action, and a hands-on activity.

#### WORKSHOPS AND CLASSES

Workshop – The Intersection of Art + Math is scheduled for November 3 & 4.

This workshop will explore the connection between visual art and mathematics. Through art-based activities, participants will explore a variety of techniques to deepen their understanding of the art + math relationship. Designed for the generalist teacher, this ten-hour workshop focuses on engaging K-8 students in creative thinking, introducing and reinforcing various math concepts, and hands-on experiences for applying math principles to create artwork. Aligned with our spring 2018 exhibit of the same theme, specific objectives will focus on guiding participants toward helping students see the connections between visual art and mathematical practices. Standards-based activities will increase participants' understanding of the meaningful connections to the Math Common Core State Standards found throughout the NCAS Anchor Standards - creating, connecting, responding and presenting. Intensive hands-on break-out sessions will be presented by experienced artists and learning specialists. Assessment strategies will be discussed and all activities are designed to be class-time efficient. Available for SPU credit/clock hours or Everett SD clock hours. This course <u>does</u> meet the STEM requirement for certification.

Art Docent Fair: Exploring Math Inspired Art through Artists Students Should Know, November 18, 8:45–12:15 p.m. Come and see artists in action and learn art projects you can do in the classroom. Presenters will focus on a different Artist Students Should Know while discussing the art elements utilized – Leonardo da Vinci, M.C. Escher, George Hart, Piet Mondrian & Faith Ringgold. Cost: \$20 per person or \$100 per school (maximum 10 packets per school). Registration form below.

Classes – Art Technique – Art How2's 2018 Part 2: Adding the "A" to STEM consists of 4 evening sessions (Apr. 18, 25, May 2, 9), 6-8:30 p.m. This workshop will highlight the value of fostering creativity in the context of STEM content areas by featuring newly adopted WA state National Core Art Standards. Participants will learn ways to teach idea generation, design, problemsolving, and critical thinking for meaningful collaboration and reflection, in your classroom. Available for SPU credit/clock hours or Everett SD/LSSD clock hours.

## **Course Objectives / Learning Outcomes**

Course Objectives: Our goal is to engage teachers with specific hands-on art activities as a means to develop a creative response to content area prompts:

- To engage students with specific hands-on art activities connected to mathematical concepts.
- To make known mathematicians who work as professional artists.
- To introduce teachers to the Schack art Center spring exhibit following the same theme as a possible field trip opportunity, bringing the year of art + math learning full circle.
- To provide a standards base and information on how to effectively embed visual art concepts pertaining to Common Core State Standards (CCSS) in math, and the newly adopted (March 2017) WA State National Core Arts Standards (NCAS)

Who is the workshop for? Teachers, youth service providers, parent volunteers, art docents, and interested individuals who want to improve their knowledge and skill and thereby feel more comfortable in teaching and creating art.
