On Jan. 23, 2018, during its regular meeting, the three board members who attended this meeting of Everett Public Schools Board of Directors did the following:

APPROVED GOING OUT TO BID FOR TWO PROJECTS

One is for <u>Elementary #18</u>, made possible by voter approval of the 2016 Construction Bond. The other is for <u>security enhancements</u> at Cedar Wood Elementary, made possible by voter approval of the 2016 Capital Levy.

REVIEWED DISTRICT PROGRESS TO READY FOR ...

Next Generation Science Standards. In 1996, Washington developed its state science standards from the National Science Education Standards. Since that time, science has advanced and changed dramatically. In spring 2013, the Updated Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS) were adopted by the state. The state and district have developed new curriculum to align with the NGSS.
