

**Calling all artists!** During the [Edge of Amazing](#) Oct. 10 and 11 summit, approximately 400 community members will gather to learn how they can make Snohomish County a healthier place to live and work. The theme for 2018 is “A STAGE FOR CHANGE”.

Artists who live in and/or create works depicting Snohomish County are invited to submit an original piece of artwork that meets the broad themes of the event and specifications listed below.

Artist submissions will be considered for the 2018 At the Edge of Amazing souvenir conference poster used to promote the event. The poster will be among conference displays and will be available to those who attend. **Artist commission is \$1,000!**

**Theme details:** Represent an aspect of Snohomish County’s health in broad terms: related to the natural environment, rural/urban health, local culture/people, agriculture/food/nutrition, healthy physical activity (walking, running, rowing, etc.), or mental/emotional well-being. **Artwork should broadly support the notion of community aspirations to make this beautiful place an even healthier place.**

**Timeline:**

- March 30 at 12 pm – abstract sketch or art submission due
- April 6 at 5 p.m. – artwork selection
- May 4 at 3 p.m. – final artwork due

**Poster requirements**

- Illustration or design image final size: 11 x 17” (portrait orientation)
- Medium: Any 2-dimensional, scannable medium is permitted (or a 300 dpi, high resolution photo can be supplied)
- Computer-generated Images: 300 dpi at 100% size, (PDF, TIFF, JPG, EPS, or PSD formats only)
- Tip: If you are producing a handmade illustration using chalk, colored pencils, watercolors, etc., please be sure to use bold, rich colors or a 20% or higher color value so it holds effectively during the scanning process.
