Staff, parents, students and community members are invited to review and provide input about the prospective middle school mathematics instructional materials at the following open houses:

Parents, middle and high school math teachers from across the district, school administrators, facilitators and administrators from district math, learning management services, English language learners and special services departments come together to synthesize research as part of the Middle School Mathematics Curriculum Materials Review Team.

This year, a team of 25 staff and community members participated in a critical analysis of middle school mathematics instructional materials. They will provide to the superintendent and school board a recommendation of an instructional program that aligns with the standards and is responsive to the needs of 21st century learners. Part of this comprehensive process is to invite staff, community members and parents to review the materials and provide input. The team will make their recommendation in May 2018.
