- (B) Focus on character, setting, dialogue and descriptive language
 - "Where did you find that?"
 - Blast from past
- (M) Focus on event
 - Mom cleaning out basement
 - Found Walkman (show students)
- (M) Focus on details and elaboration
 - Compared size Walkman and tiny iPod
 - Remembered homemade tapes
 - Improved technology
- (E) Focus on emotion
 - Easier now download songs
 - Couldn't imagine (amazed) difference between then and now
