ECEAP HEARING & VISION SCREENING

TIMEFRAME:

Initial fall screenings are due 60 days from the child's class start date. For children who enroll after the start of the year hearing & vision screenings are still due within 60 days of a child's actual start date.

SCHEDULING:

- Usually takes a couple days to check all children, especially with absences
- For children who enroll after first day, screen hearing & vision as soon as possible, and within 60 days of their first day in class

INTERPRETING RESULTS:

Guidelines for screening results:

- 3 year olds Normal = 20/50, Rescreen for 20/60 and 1 line differences, Refer at above 20/60
- 4 year olds Normal = 20/40, Rescreen for 20/50 and 1 line differences, Refer at 20/60 or above

DOCUMENTING RESULTS & REPORTING:

Fill out Hearing & Vision Screening Form for Parents, make a copy and send home original (English, Spanish)

• File copy in individual child files

Record screening in ELMS (can do in Bulk Update)

- Note date of screening
- Note result of screening: Pass, Fail or Unable to determine
- If referral was provided, go to individual child record, Health Screenings tab and record date of referral.
 - Follow-up with family regarding referral, once they see a health care provider, record date and results for treatment needs in ELMS

RE-SCREENING:

Who to rescreen? Complete rescreening for the following children:

- Initial screening results were "Unable to determine"
- Initial screening results were between normal/passing and referral guidelines above

When to rescreen?

- Rescreen within 60 days of initial screening (new guideline)
- Recommend re-screening about 6 weeks after initial screening to allow for referral and follow-up time if needed
