Share your thoughts about planning for high school growth

Committee forming to examine options; launching public comment opportunity

At its regular meeting on July 3, the Everett Public Schools Board of Directors approved a motion that directed the superintendent to “bring a proposal to the August 28, 2018 board meeting for its approval defining a committee process, guiding principles, participants, and timeline to develop a plan to temporarily mitigate the effects of high school growth. The committee is to recommend revisions to high school enrollment boundaries beginning fall 2020 to reduce enrollment at Jackson HS; and complementary and practical program changes, portable classrooms, and minor schedule changes.”

As part of this process, the district is asking for public comments through an open-ended question online survey available on the [High School Growth Mitigation Committee website](#). The comment period is open through Aug. 15, 2018.

The district held three community conversations in May to answer public questions and gather comments regarding how to best mitigate the growth facing the district.
