Students from two Everett high schools compete in Transatlantic Soccer Bridge

Everett School District's H.M. Jackson and Cascade high schools German Club students and teams from seven other Washington high schools will compete on Saturday, May 9 in an international soccer tournament.

This is the eighth year that Jackson students and the German Club from Cascade have played "football" in this tournament sponsored by the American Association of German Teachers (AATG), Goethe Institute (San Francisco branch), and the Zentralstelle fuer das Auslandsschulwesen (ZfA), which is also known as the Central Agency for German Schools Abroad.
