Submission rules, terms and conditions:

1. Please submit high-resolution (minimum 3200 pixels along the longest edge) digital images or scans of children's art, or their digital photos, in a TIF or low-compressed JPG format. Images larger than 3200 pixels across are preferred.
2. The artwork and images should promote healing, health and community.
3. Entries that are submitted will belong to Swedish, although if the submission is a digital

image of a child's artwork, then the original may be retained by the artist; chosen entries may be collaged together, as space and design permits.

4. All submissions must be **emailed** to **swedishartmillcreek@gmail.com** by 11:59 p.m. PST on Nov. 1. Please include the child or young adult's full name in the email.
5. All submissions must be accompanied by a **release form** signed by a parent or guardian and **emailed** to **swedishartmillcreek@gmail.com** by 11:59 p.m. PST on Nov. 1.
6. While this is not a formal contest, space limits the number of images that will be selected.

We welcome all entrants and their families to the grand opening celebration that will include recognizing the winners and their resulting art pieces. More information about the opening events will come soon.
