

World Language credit for proficiency, fall 2015

Give yourself some credit! Register by Oct. 8, 2015

Can you fluently read, write, speak, and listen in a language other than English?

In Everett Public Schools, you can earn high school credit in a world language by successfully passing district-approved assessments and demonstrating your language proficiency in listening, speaking, reading, and writing. You may also earn a <u>Seal of Biliteracy</u> on your high school diploma for demonstrating a high level of language proficiency.

What will the test cost?

The cost is \$20 for the languages tested in fall 2015. (the cost of assessment varies by language test). Students interested in establishing proficiency through an assessment option are responsible for the test cost.
