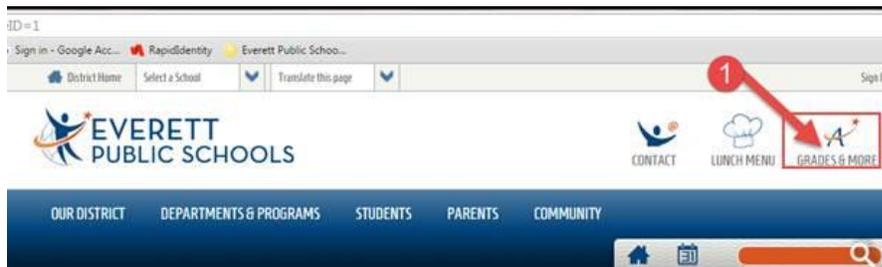

- then network password (same password used to log on to a computer at school)
