





What is the Difference?

Goal: something that you are trying to do or achieve

Example – I will set my alarm to wake up 15 minutes early Monday – Friday during the 2017-2018 school year to make sure I leave my house on time and get to school.


A GOAL WITHOUT A PLAN IS JUST A WISH.



What is a S.M.A.R.T Goal?

To convert your **wish** into a **goal** you need to have a plan.

Using the **S.M.A.R.T Goal** formula will help you plan for the goal you want to achieve.







You will now see your action steps or To-do's.




