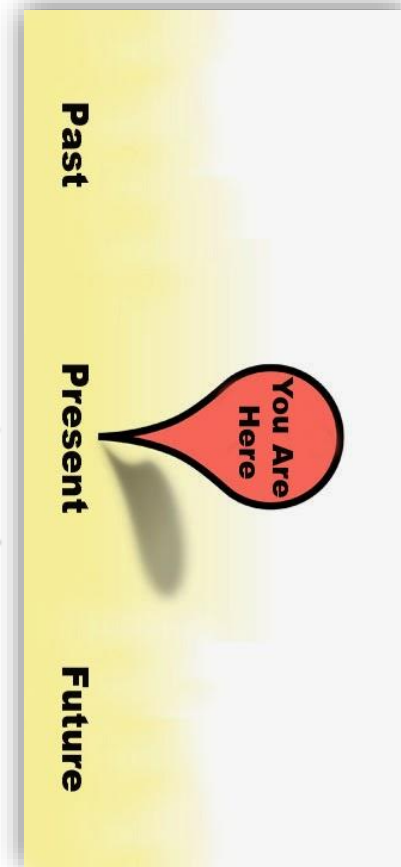

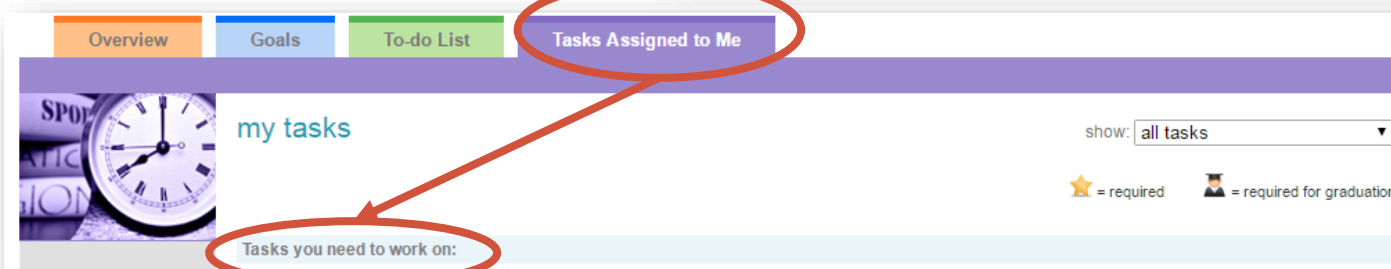
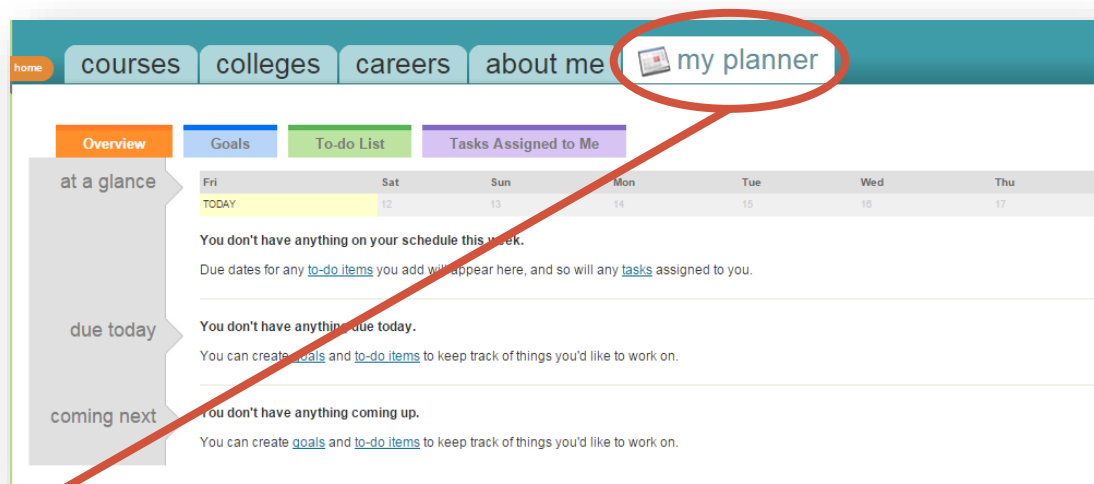

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# What is the Difference?

**Wish:** to want (something) to be true or to happen

*Example – I want to be on time to school every day.*

**Goal:** something that you are trying to do or achieve

*Example – I will set my alarm to wake up 15 minutes early Monday – Friday during the 2017-2018 school year to make sure I leave my house on time and get to school.*

# What is a S.M.A.R.T Goal?

To convert your **wish** into a **goal** you need to have a plan.

Using the **S.M.A.R.T Goal** formula will help you plan for the goal you want to achieve.

**S**PECIFIC

What exactly is it you want to achieve?

**M**EASURABLE

How can you measure and track the progress of the goal?

**A**TTAINABLE

Is it actually attainable in the given time frame?

**R**ELEVANT

Is it something that you really want to do? Will it directly benefit you?

**T**IME BOUND

When do you want to achieve this goal by?

# 6<sup>th</sup> Grade is a Transition Time

Attendance	Organization	Work Completion

Talk to teachers about assignments when absent from school.	Writing homework assignments, tests, quizzes in a planner	Writing down due dates for assignments and projects in my planner
Ask teachers for extra help or additional time on assignments if needed.	Coming prepared to class with pencils, books, paper etc.	Turning assignments and projects in on time.



Timely: When can you achieve this goal?





# Time for Action!

Once your goal is created, you will be prompted to come up with at least one action step.



Click **define your next step**

This looks like a great goal! Now, it's time to think about what steps you are going to take to achieve it.

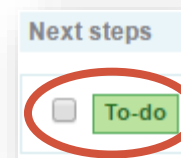
 

In the box provided, type one thing you plan to do in the next 1-2 weeks that will help you achieve your goal.
