

RESOLUTION NO. 17

WHEREAS, THE ELECTORS OF EVERETT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 2 ON NOVEMBER 5, 1946 APPROVED A TEN MILL LEVY FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAINTENANCE, REPAIRS, IMPROVEMENT AND REHABILITATION OF EXISTING SCHOOL BUILDINGS, AND

WHEREAS, MONEY LEVIED FOR THIS PURPOSE HAS BEEN EXPENDED, AND

WHEREAS, THE ELECTORS OF SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 2 ON NOVEMBER 2, 1948 APPROVED BY A SUBSTANTIAL MAJORITY A TEN MILL LEVY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONTINUANCE OF MAINTENANCE, REPAIR, IMPROVEMENTS AND REHABILITATION OF EXISTING SCHOOL BUILDINGS, AND

WHEREAS, BY THIS VOTE THEY INDICATED THE WORK OF MODERNIZATION OF BUILDINGS SHOULD CONTINUE, AND

WHEREAS, FUNDS THAT WERE VOTED ON NOVEMBER 2, 1948 ARE NOT AVAILABLE UNTIL JULY 1, 1949, AND

WHEREAS, THERE IS NOW AN URGENT NEED OF REPAIR, IMPROVEMENT AND REHABILITATION OF CERTAIN SCHOOL BUILDINGS AND IN ORDER THIS WORK CAN BE ACCOMPLISHED DURING SUMMER VACATION, IT IS NECESSARY THIS MONEY BE MADE AVAILABLE AT THIS TIME,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT AN EMERGENCY DOES EXIST AND THAT FUNDS BE MADE NOW AVAILABLE FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONTINUANCE OF MAINTENANCE, REPAIRS, IMPROVEMENT, MODERNIZATION AND REHABILITATION OF EXISTING SCHOOL BUILDINGS.
