Regarding: Announcing Everett Virtual Academy

Dear Everett Public Schools' families,

As we finish up this school year, I want to thank you all for your resiliency and support. We are so excited to be back in person 100% in the fall. We also know from our [family survey](#) earlier this spring there are some families who would like to pursue 100% remote learning because their child thrived in that environment. To serve those families, we are launching Everett Virtual Academy, a virtual school for grades K – 8.

Everett Virtual Academy (EVA) is remote learning designed to engage students in live, synchronous learning with their teacher for a minimum of 70% of their day, and teacher-led asynchronous learning for the remainder of their day. Students are required to attend live, instructional blocks through Zoom and to access online curriculum and resources through Canvas. Additional live small group time may be scheduled by the classroom teachers.

The EVA student schedule will follow the traditional school day and daily attendance is required. If you are interested in finding out more about Everett Virtual Academy, please visit the webpage at www.everettsd.org/everettvirtualacademy.
