Middle School Administrator Instructions

Purpose: provide diagnostics in reading and math to determine which students need additional supports by measuring progress against benchmarks in fall, winter, and spring.

Schedule:

Fall: September 7-October 7Winter: January 4-February 10

• Spring: May 1-June 9


Expectations:

Administrators ensure that students complete the math and reading diagnostics with fidelity.

- Ensure teachers comply with expectations:
 - Provide sufficient time for students to complete the diagnostic (estimated at 45 minutes per diagnostic) in an appropriate testing environment.
 - o Ensure students do not access other programs, websites, or cell phones.
 - o Encourage students to do their best work.
 - o Review student progress to ensure:
 - students complete the diagnostic in time
 - students flagged for rushing are addressed (see below)
- Reset rush flagged diagnostics as needed
- Monitor completion and ensure students are assessed during the set windows

Check for Completion:

- 1. Log in with your administrator credentials at https://login.i-ready.com/
- 2. You should land on the **Diagnostic Status Card** but click it if it's not already open.
- 3. Then select the **subject**.



- 4. This will take you to a summary roster by grade level. The columns indicate various statuses and alerts. From here you can:
 - Click the grade level to see class summaries at that grade level, or
 - Use the drop down to see summaries for all classes or report groups

Communicate with staff who are behind in progress, have expiring assessments, or rush flags (red or yellow).

5. When looking at the class summary, click on the **class name** to see the student roster for that class.

What to do about Alerts



Expiring Test: Incomplete tests expire at 21 days after the student begins the diagnostic and must be started over.



Red Rush Flag: the student moved at far too fast a pace to have an accurate score.



Yellow Rush Flag: the student moved at a suspicious pace. The score may not be accurate.

What to do: Have the student complete the test as soon as possible. If the test expires, and the student can't get in, <u>reassign</u>.

What to do: The student should retake the diagnostic. <u>Instructions</u>

What to do: Teachers use professional judgement and knowledge of the student to decide if the score is reasonable. If not, follow <u>instructions</u>.
