School Day	Extended Support/ Lighthouse	Athletic Coach
Volunteer activities take place during the school day. Includes Field Trips that take place between school hours. School Day Volunteers work near district employees. Approved Volunteers who are not listed in Frontline are considered School Day Volunteers and can volunteer at any school.  School Day volunteers may not go on overnight trips or support after school activities.	Volunteer activities take place outside of the school day (overnight camp, after school and evening activities).  Extended Support Volunteers may not be in direct proximity of a district employee and who provide substantial assistance.  Lighthouse Volunteer activities may lead small groups and can also serve as well as overnight chaperone, volunteer club advisor, and program booster.  Extended Support Volunteers may serve as School Day Volunteers.	Volunteers who support middle and high school athletic teams.  Volunteer Athletic Coaches may serve as Extended Support and School Day Volunteers.
