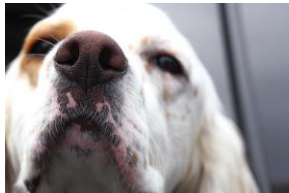

Science Behind the Animal & Bug Hunt or Walk

You were just exploring different animals and bugs in their **habitats** and predicting (making an informed guess about) what they might need to survive.

What is a **habitat**? A **habitat** is where a plant or animal lives.

Visit the **Woodland Park Zoo's Bug World** and learn about the bugs.

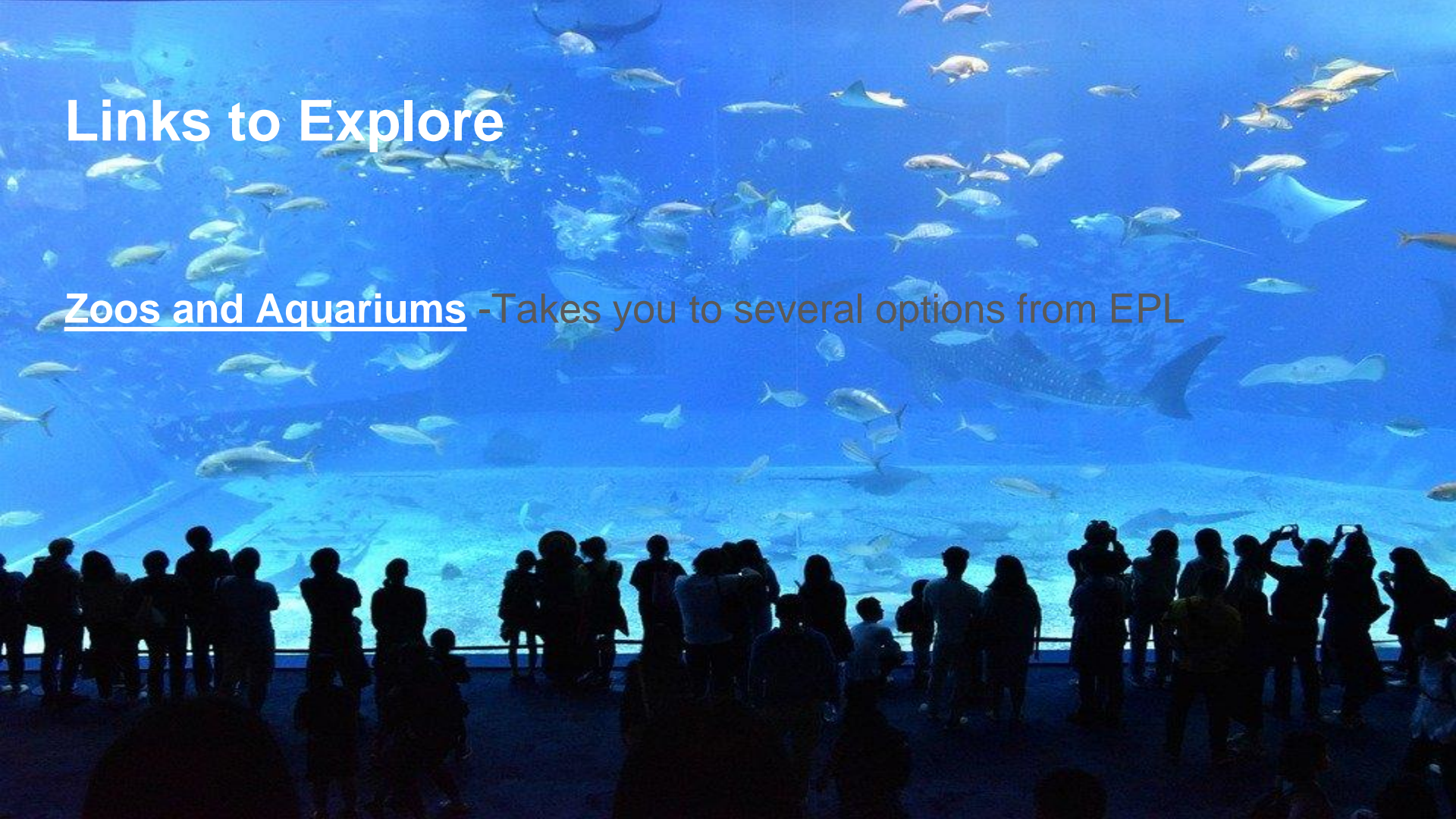


Build a Bug Hotel around your neighborhood and keep track of the critters it attracts!
